Information about the neighborhood and city (video)	<p>Granada is the capital city of the province of Granada, in the autonomous community of Andalusia, Spain. Granada is located at the foot of the Sierra Nevada mountains, at the confluence of four rivers, and only one hour by car from the Mediterranean coast, the Costa Tropical.</p> <p>The city has a vast history. It was first settled by Iberians, Romans, and Visigoths. The current settlement became a major city of Al-Andalus in the 11th century. In the 13th century it became the capital of the Emirate of Granada under Nasrid rule until 1492, when it was conquered by the Catholic Monarchs and progressively transformed into a Christian city over the course of the 16th century.</p> <p>The Alhambra, a medieval Nasrid citadel and palace, is located in Granada. It is one of the most famous monuments of Islamic architecture and one of the most visited tourist sites in Spain. Islamic-period influence and Moorish architecture are also preserved in the Albaicín neighborhood and other medieval monuments in the city. The 16th century also saw a flourishing of other important artistic styles.</p>

The university has become internationally recognised in many university fields: teaching, research, cultural and services to its members and its surroundings. <p>Getting to school/Travelling</p>	<p>The main company operating bus transport in Granada is the company Alsa, which also offers a bus transportation to and from the airport, Federico García Lorca Airport, about 15 km (9 mi) west of Granada.</p> <p>Granada railway station has rail connections with many cities in Spain. There are several types of train service to and from Granada</p> <p>Granada has a wide network of taxis to help travellers reach their destinations. Official Granada taxis are white with a green stripe. We also have a Metro (partially underground), which covers the whole city from north to south.</p>
